InfraGard is a partnership between the FBI and the private sector, which includes an association of business, academia, state and local law enforcement, government, and other participants dedicated to sharing information and intelligence to prevent hostile acts against the United States. InfraGard provides formal and informal channels for the exchange of information about our nation's critical infrastructure and key resources. Since most infrastructure components are privately owned, it is crucial that we, as the FBI, communicate directly with the private sector.

The Oklahoma Chapter of InfraGard has been a valuable resource for the FBI due to the generation and enhancement of cases and intelligence. The Oklahoma InfraGard Chapter has done an excellent job in assisting the FBI and providing essential intelligence information. It is noted that information obtained from active Oklahoma InfraGard members has resulted in six cases being opened in 2008 and information from InfraGard members which has resulted in two cases being opened in 2009. There were 34 cases which were enhanced by Oklahoma InfraGard members. The Oklahoma Chapter was number one in this category when compared to other Chapters nationwide.

A threat to our nation's critical infrastructure challenges the foundations of American society and we have to work together to combat the threat. We appreciate the work Oklahoma InfraGard members have done to make this country safer.
